


Section Six: Brief Statement

Bentonville Kids Come First is a community organization of concerned parents advocating the passage of a proposed millage question for the Bentonville School District. The proposed 3.6 mill increase would raise approximately \$70,000,000 to fund the construction of two new school buildings, provide renovation funds for existing facilities, purchase land, fund site improvements and provide operating funds. The legislative question will be presented to the voters on April 13, 2010.
