
1. A temporary 1/2 cent sales tax dedicated to the construction of a new jail facility and sheriff's office. The temporary tax will expire when the bonds are repaid, guaranteed to be paid off in 10 year.
2. A 1/4 cent sales tax dedicated to maintaining and operating the jail facility which will restore law, order and justice for Crawford County Citizens.

The committee was formed to advocate FOR the passage of the sales tax by educating the voters on the issues, such as overcrowding, loss of revenue from inadequate jail space and the increase in crime that is occurring due to revolving door of the current jail.

The issue as proposed by the Quorum Court of Crawford County will be on all May 20th primary ballots.
