

The Stop Casinos Now Committee will advocate for the defeat of two proposed amendments to the constitution of Arkansas that would provide unregulated monopolies to private entities for conducting casino wagering in the state. These proposed amendments, one submitted by Nancy Todd's Poker Palace and Entertainment Venues, LLC and the other by Arkansas Hotels and Entertainment, Inc., would also prohibit the state or any local government from policing and regulating the casino gambling conducted by these private entities. If qualified, these proposals would be presented to a popular vote of the people on November 6, 2012.
